SUDAN MISSION

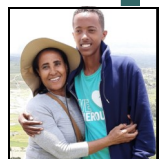


The LORD and our Board are sending me back to the **UN Tigrayan Refugee Camps** in Sudan this October. The Christian families and orphans there are greatly suffering. First monsoon rains and wind caused substantial damage to their simple structures. Then the **World Food Program** reduced their food rations by 50%! The children especially are in great need, many are cold and hundreds have contacted us asking for help.

I'm not going on my own. I'll be traveling with Christian doctors we assisted last October, the **Professional Network for Tigray**. They have an established clinic in one of the camps. We now have many contacts in Khartoum as well in the camps with whom we can partner. I'm counting on your prayers and support, as I seek to raise **\$30,000** for this effort, in order to supply food and clothing to those most in need.

Pray that God blesses our team travel arrangements, obtaining our visas, accommodations, interpreters, local church partners and sympathetic **UN Staff** in this Muslim land. Because of the military coup last October, the streets are still filled with protestors. Corruption is huge, shortages are everywhere, yet the LORD is also active bringing salvation and hope. Please help me to share the Gospel!
