"At dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.... Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers...." Matthew 28

orld elites, for the sake of power and control, divide everyone into winners, and losers, the oppressed, and the oppressors, by race, class, or sex. At the time of Jesus' Resurrection, women were big losers, with second-rate status. Their legal rights were practically nonexistent. They were treated as property, considered uneducable, regarded as too unreliable to testify in a courtroom.

Yet every Gospel account proclaims women as the first official witnesses of the Resurrection. The ladies, last at the cross, first at the tomb, are given starring roles. Why did Jesus come to sisters before he came to brothers? Are women primary in God's eyes? Not at all, but Jesus came to destroy divisions. Easter blew them away.



In fact, look a little closer at those accounts. What *kind* of women were they? **Mary Magdalene** was a woman with a scandalous, shameful past. Elites separate everyone into moral, "virtuous" insiders (like them) and the immoral "nasty" outsiders.

But Jesus blows this division between "good" and "bad" people out of the water too. He chooses to reveal himself first to Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of James and Joses—to outsiders, not insiders.

I think Jesus is saying, "If I was like the founders of other religions, just giving you my teaching, then those who were able to follow it would be accepted and those who were unable would be rejected. But I have not come to merely give you my TEACHING, but chiefly to give you ME. I am the risen Lord. Since it is ME, my work, my death, my resurrection that saves you, and not your own efforts, anyone can be part of my forever FAMILY by trusting in me."

Jesus reveals Himself to the women before the men, the poor before the rich. Today Christianity is doing very well in Africa, Asia, and Latin America, and not terribly well in Europe and even America. Christ moves away from power, away from the influence, away from the people who think they are in charge, away from the people who think they are good. He blows apart the old divisions between somebodies and nobodies, creating a new family that will "reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility" (Eph.2). 

THE HORN OF AFRICA IS UNRAVELING



hile conflicts in **Ukraine** and **Gaza** retain the greatest media attention, no suffering in the world today is greater than in the Horn of Africa. Though a peace treaty for the warring sides in **Ethiopia** was signed almost two years ago, after 600,000 deaths and 8 million refugees, it has not been implemented. International Aid is still stymied, with "at least 33,000 children in parts of **Tigray**, Ethiopia, at imminent risk of death as conflict increases famine threat " (today's *UNICEF*). Rebels in **Yemen** are challenging global shipping in the **Red**



Sea. Two fully armed forces are devastating **Sudan**, where a Wagner like paramilitary supported by Russia, is looting, raping, and destroy-

ing in the midst of the 8 million inhabitants of **Khartoum**. According to the *Economist*, part of Sudan's affliction is "the wider world's utter indifference". The great powers barely pay attention.

Somalia is facing an all out fight for survival against al-Shabbat militants, while facing a diplomatic crisis with neighboring Ethiopia over the breakaway region of Somaliland. The situation in Eritrea remains a huge prison camp, with expatriates able to escape sounding the alarm in public demonstrations around the world. We recognize Satan's attacks on this strategic region, and ask you to join with us in placing the HORN OF AFRICA and every person there into the Father's hands.
