THE GIFTS OF EASTER



t is usually Christmas that sparks the idea of gift-giving, but we believe Easter is better suited to it.

That's because as soon as Jesus Christ shows up risen from the dead, you see how many times He says receive! "Receive the Holy Spirit!" "Peace be to you!" He is giving out all kinds of newness. It culminates with the risen Christ in the last book of the Bible proclaiming, "Behold, I make all things new!"

After all, **Jesus** is not a dead teacher the way founders of world religions like **Buddha** or **Muhammad** are. He isn't a religion at all. He is a power! He is alive, risen, having arms outstretched with gifts.

For example, Jesus can give you faith. Faith isn't a commodity you can manufacture. Faith is not something we can spin out of our own soul, the way a spider spins out a web. Each of us is a natural skeptic. "Faith...is a gift of God" (Ephesians 2:8). All the Easter accounts remind us that even Jesus' closest disciples doubted and deserted Him as He was crucified, and buried.

hink about it! Mary had witnessed the miracles-she had even seen Jesus raise people from the dead! She heard Jesus claim over and over again that He would rise from the dead. Even Jesus' enemies knew of this claimthat's why they placed a guard over His tomb. Mary had never heard Jesus say anything that hadn't been fulfilled. And yet, as soon as she approaches the empty tomb, seeing the stone off to the side, her response isn't faith: "It happened! He did it! He is risen!" No, her response is tearful despair: "They took it! Everything is lost. Woe is me!"

But this Risen Jesus comes with gifts. He approaches Mary, imparting faith. He finds Peter, Thomas, and the other disciples, one by one. He approaches each one of us, calling us by name, bringing the gift of faith. He finds us in our dark hopelessness, freely forgiving our sin. He brings us His Peace, that passes understanding. He unites us with his Spirit, filling us with power to change.

When Jesus finds us full of doubts, deserters who gave up on him, or even enemies who crucified him, he invites us to stand beside Him as brothers and sisters, fellow heirs of the Kingdom of God. The determining factor in your relationship with God is not your past, but Christ's past; not your record, but Christ's record. That's the Good News of Easter!
